Typical Outside Campground Duties: assisting in parking RV's, bicycle maintenance and repair, blow leaves and other debris from building areas, pool decks, parking lots and streets, carpentry construction and repair, clean an organize maintenance shop, clean barbeque grills, clean fire rings, deliver firewood to camp sites, deliver pizza to camp sites, electrical repair, empty trash cans, escort RV's, glass repair, golf cart maintenance and repair, laying and grouting tile, meter reading, mowing – zero clearance rider, open enclosure doors to expose dumpster, painting, plant and maintain flower beds, plumbing maintenance and repair, pool maintenance and repair, power wash patios, sidewalks and buildings, rake leaves, refill pet waste bags, screen repair, security patrol, small equipment maintenance and repair, spread fertilizer, spread mulch, spread weed killer, trim shrubs, trim trees and weed whack trimming.
